- Planning to support the Chancellor in lifting the student voice












Following Mode of Instruction Over Time

Section Instructional Mode as a Percentage of Total Sections¹ by Sector and Collection Date



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








Students On Campus as of October 15th







SUNY Online Education: COVID-19 Support (data as of 1/15/21)

- COVID-19 Website (launched 3/13)
 - **23,282** users **25,253** sessions
 - **70,360** page views **56,766** unique page views
- Remote Teaching Clinic (launched 3/16)
 - 31,851 registrations for 121 topics from 64 campuses
 - 3,295 non-duplicated registrants for the RTC in general.
 - 8,886 webinar recording views on YouTube
- Faculty Drop-in Hours (3/13 6/30)
 - 519 faculty consultations from 41 campuses
- Student Drop-in Hours (3/22 5/31)
 - 249 student consultations from 35 campuses

- Help Desk (available since 3/2)
 - 37,367 tickets logged from 64 campuses
 - **15,818** from students, **18,355** from faculty, **3194** from campus staff
 - Biggest issues are course content creation,
 Collaborate, assignments, discussions, use of media,
 tests/surveys/polls, and third party applications
- Bb Collaborate (free through Summer 2020)
 - **15** new campuses (from 23 to 38)
- Bb Ally (free through Fall 2020)
 - 8 new campuses (from 36 to 44)






Student Mental Health & Wellness Task Force

- Convened by the Provost in Sept 2019
- Representatives from campuses, SUNY System, state and external experts, UFS and FCCC presidents serve
- Charge:
 - Develop a menu of universal-level public health-informed mental health best practices and evidence-based programs
 - Establish guidelines for mental health service delivery that are responsive to diverse needs
 - Identify avenues to provide technical assistance and seek additional funding opportunities











Student Mental Health & Wellness Task Force

- Paused in March 2020, resumed Dec 2020
- Staff Assessment out to campuses Dec 2020
 - Data cleaning and analysis in Jan/Feb 2021
- Student Mental Health Opinions Survey started Dec 2020
 - Student leaders, available residential students, resident life directors, social media distribution
 - Continuing survey dissemination spring 2021
- Final report and recommendations spring 2021











SUNY Online – Degrees at Scale Initiative (Fall 2020)

- Nine campuses, 22 programs, 6 pathways (Digital Security, Psychology, Health Care Mgmt., Business/Accounting, Data Science, Engineering)
- Online Advisory Group convened in May; five subcommittees
- To date, 391 course sections delivered via a common course template and partial implementation of common SUNY IT Solutions
- Validation and completed financial model for review (revenue share to allow scalability)
- Spring 2021 marketing campaign planned. Target enrollment goals:

SUNY General Education Revision: Summary of GEAC Work

- Values. Established core values and guiding principles to inform revision of SUNY-GER.
- <u>Compliance</u>. Defined the external policies and guidelines that SUNY-GER must comply with, such as Middle States standards and NYS Commissioner Regulations.
- <u>Information Management</u>. Recommended revisions to the Information Management competency and learning outcomes.
- <u>Diversity</u>. The first report recommended guiding principles and updates to the existing categories
 of Other World Civilizations and Foreign Language. The second subcommittee report
 recommended the establishment of a Diversity category and learning outcomes. Currently under
 review for alignment with the Chancellor's Equity Action Plan.
- <u>Critical Thinking</u>. Recommended revisions to the Critical Thinking competency and learning outcomes.
- <u>Global Learning</u>. Recommended a new category and learning outcomes for Global Learning, in alignment with the Global Learning for All initiative.
- <u>History</u>. Reviewed existing History categories and made recommendations for streamlining and updating learning outcomes.




