Summary of committee actions since previous plenary:

The committee has reviewed the new SUNY Diversity Action Plan. As a follow-up to some of the action items in the plan as well as the Fall 2020 UFS resolution on Racial Equity and Social Justice Curriculum, and considering the differences between the sectors and campuses within the system, the committee plans to send out a survey to assess in more detail the faculty needs that various campuses have in implementing these plans. We are specifically interested in the faculty perspective.

The committee has also reviewed the proposed new SUNY General Education framework and will submit comments to the Task Force.

The committee has taken initial steps towards creating a toolkit to offer inclusive education and Diversity resources to faculty and institutions in various academic disciplines.
