During the Fall Plenary 2021, SUNY University Faculty Senate passed Communications Committee sponsored "Executive Budget Resolution", Res. #: 189-02-1, urging Governor Hochul to craft an Executive Budget that makes New York State a national leader in sustainably and equitably supporting and advancing SUNY and CUNY's core academic missions. Our Resolution passed with a vote of: 43 For, 0 Against, and 2 Abstained
- b. UFS Connects Published 5 pieces. 2 of them contributed by Sarah Battaglia. "UFS Member Honors Veterans as UUP Representative" and "The Coexistence of Difference and Diversity: "the Borough of my Soul"
