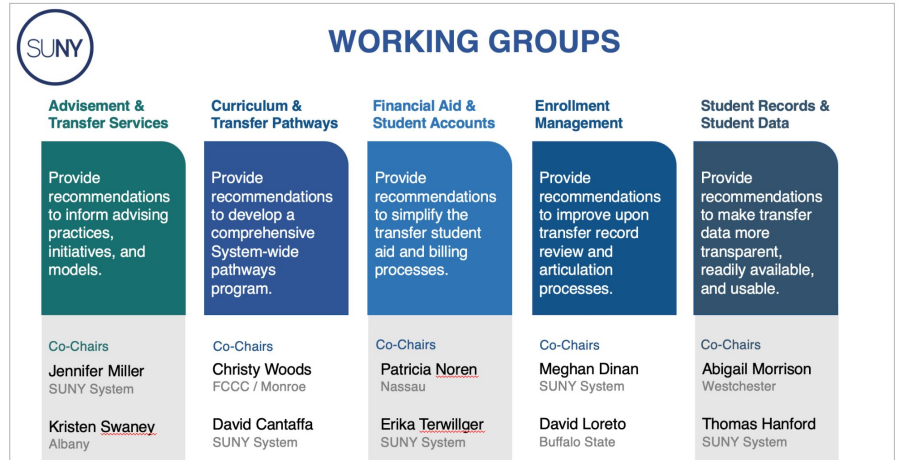
Transfer Task Force

Chaddock & Cramer Outstanding Mentoring Award

PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

The Chaddock & Cramer/University Faculty Senate Outstanding Mentoring Award is conferred by the University Faculty|Senate Executive Committee. Mentoring of junior governance members by senior members has been a long-standing tradition of many governance leaders in both UFS and on-campus governance units. This unwritten code has enabled many UFS leaders to learn to **put things in perspective and evaluate alternatives** – in terms of governance, career, and life challenges. This award, proposed in 2019, is offered by two UFS governance leaders who owe many of their own successes to such mentoring, and who wish to highlight mentoring as an explicit goal of UFS participation and service.

Nominees for the award must have achieved a reputation for outstanding mentoring of governance colleagues in the area of faculty governance at **both** the System (e.g., UFS) *and* Campus levels. Consideration will be given for a sustained level of commitment for a minimum of seven (7) years.

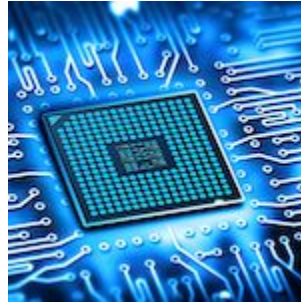
