VOTE: For: 41 / Against: 0 (without dissent)

RATIONALE:

WHEREAS SUNY campuses are facing significant financial challenges in recent years caused by factors including declining state funding, rising costs, lower enrollment, and increasing competition for students; and

WHEREAS SUNY Potsdam¹ and SUNY Fredonia² have released blueprints developed by campus leadership to ensure a stronger future; and

WHEREAS Buffalo State University, SUNY Delhi, and SUNY Maritime are continuing along their paths to fiscal sustainability and strong futures³; and

WHEREAS the Clinton Community College and SUNY Plattsburgh collaboration⁴ has been presented as a financial stability strategy; and

WHEREAS the restructuring of SUNY Downstate⁵ has been presented as a financial stability strategy; and

WHEREAS the other SUNY campuses can benefit from lessons learned by these campuses currently going through their roadmaps; and

WHEREAS the SUNY University Faculty Senate (UFS) needs to have accurate and up-to-date information on the financial sustainability of SUNY campuses to proactively respond to fiscal sustainability planning and action;

RESOLUTION:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that SUNY UFS requests that the SUNY Chancellor and System Administration provide a progress report on the financial sustainability of SUNY campuses; and
